Adult Classes (9:00 am)

Dwelling in the Word – Kids Classroom Downstairs

Every week, this class reads and reflects on a passage of Scripture—often the passage that is read early in our service. Together, we pay attention to the things that stick out to us and ask, “what might God be saying to us, today, through this passage?” Join us as we seek to dwell in the Word.

Isaiah – Adults Classroom Downstairs

Wayne Shockley is leading a class through the book of Isaiah, focusing on understanding and interpretation. Together, we discuss what the prophet might have meant, and what these texts mean for us today. Join us as we explore Isaiah together!

Children’s Classes (10:00)

Every Sunday morning we offer fun and interactive kids programming from Pre-K through elementary school. Classes include play and age-appropriate learning. We use Sparkhouse “Whirl” curriculum, which follows the Church Calendar and lessons are based on the Revised Common Lectionary readings for each Sunday of the year, just as we do in Adult Worship. Both age groups study the same passage, in age appropriate ways.
