Dear Westwood Christian Church,

God continues to do amazing things all around the world through IDES. Your partnership has recently resulted in rice seed for planting and homes rebuilt in Myanmar following destruction from the current military coup, irrigated farms for hundreds of people in the deserts of Kenya, baptisms in a closed country following a clean water project, and over 80 baptisms and 750 homes rebuilt in the Philippines as a result of typhoon relief efforts there. I recently returned from Ukraine, Poland, and Romania where YOU are helping provide food and shelter for four refugee camps IDES is funding. These camps have provided thousands of sheltered nights and meals since the beginning of Russia's invasion.

Right now, here in the US, IDES continues to rebuild homes in Kentucky following December's devastating tornado. We have also responded to tornados in Wichita, KS and Goshen, OH and as I write this we are preparing to respond to massive flooding in St. Louis and Kentucky. You are part of God's work around the world and right here at home.

Our US Disaster Response Coordinator told me about a conversation he had with a family who suffered damage from the tornado in Goshen, Ohio. There were three adults and seven children living in a double-wide mobile home. As he delivered supplies and a generator to the family, they asked how to get in touch with and plugged into our partner church, Heartland Christian Church. God is opening doors to **Hope** even right now through the **Help** you are helping to provide.
