In 1973, George Steinbrenner led a group that purchased the New York Mets for 10 million dollars. The Miami Dolphins won the Super Bowl and completed the season as the only undefeated NFL team. The Supreme Court overturns state bans on abortion. U.S. involvement in the Vietnam War ended with the signing of the Paris Peace Accords. The Godfather wins the Oscar for best picture. Federal Express officially begins operations. The Watergate hearings began and were fully televised on TV. Vice President Spiro Agnew resigned in October and the US Senate voted for Gerald Ford to replace him 1 month later. And in the midst of these historic events, Milton Bates would meet with several ministers at the North American Christian Convention in Indianapolis, IN where IDES was born.
