Ukraine



The battered and destroyed town of Posad Pokrovske is home to a new church plant. There are about 800 people left in town and about 70 are now attending church. Due to severe bombing and shelling, there is no stable potable water supply. We have drilled a well at the church. Pray for protection.

India



With a focus on evangelism, we are helping partners in India build a church. This is a part of our 50 for 50 church initiative. Since persecution is high in this area, pray for protection as they share the gospel. Pray their efforts would glorify God and bring people to Jesus.

Haiti




With the ongoing conflict in Haiti, many people are facing severe hunger issues. With help from partners, over 64,000 meals were provided to 1800 people, and in many cases, this was the only source of food they had. This project also allowed the gospel to be preached which led to 37 people accepting Christ. Praise God!

GAP Packs



We have GAP food packs this month in TN, KY, IN, and MO. With over 1.4 million meals packed this year so far, pray that these efforts will both feed the hungry and glorify God beyond our ability.

Iowa



We are working with Early Chapel Christian Church of Earlham, IA, to build sheds and help those recover from the tornados this past May. Pray for their continued recovery and spiritual health.

Chile



Earlier this year, wildfires spread in the Quilpue region of Chile. IDES was able to help provide 10,000 meals and repair 4 homes, as well as distribute 400 Bibles.

We have also helped rebuild/repair 8 homes. Praise God for what He is doing!
